We will start playing the recorder in January. Students should have their own recorder for class. A good recorder is essential for good music making.

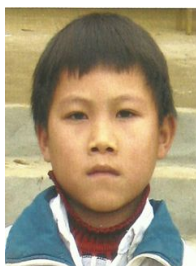
Recorders can be found at the Yamaha dealer on the 2nd floor of E-Mart or 7th floor of Shinsegae. Please purchase the following:
